Conditions of Entry

The One Day Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). There will be no crew limits. ISAF Category 5 regulations regarding safety shall apply. Race announcements will be made on VHF Channel 77 from around 09:00 including the Committee Boat location on the Sunday.

Courses and Sailing Instructions

Racing on Sunday will take place in the central Solent. Races 1 & 2 will be W-L and generally use laid marks. Race 3 will use laid marks or a combination of laid and fixed marks in accordance with the sailing instructions. Sailing instructions will be available on www.sigma38.co.uk before the closing date and will be available from the club. RYA Arbitration will be available for this event and the exoneration scoring penalty will be 25%.

Scoring and Prize Giving

Scoring for the three race series will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A with no discard. Prize giving will be held as soon as possible after racing on Sunday at the Royal London Yacht Club, Cowes. Boats that are dressed may berth on the Trinity Landing for the prize giving period.

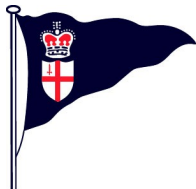
Accommodation and Moorings
